About DBNC's Community Care Closet

We are excited to present DBNC's newest initiative: the Community Care Closet which will be used to respond to individuals and families experiencing food, clothing, and personal product insecurity in the Peel Region. We are currently collecting donations in order to launch in **January**, **2023**.

Closet recipients complete an online intake form where they can choose items they need for the month, as well as a pick-up time. This emphasizes autonomy and visibility and provides a more equitable system for all recipients. We also conducted multiple client needs assessments in order to better understand what items were most needed in the Care Closet.

No one expects to need food & clothing relief but we want to be there for our community if the unexpected happens!
